

WHICH CARD DO I USE?

MEDICARE

Once you enroll into Medicare insurance, you will receive your Medicare ID card. This card will be red, white, and blue.

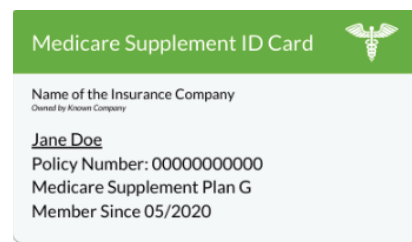
MEDICARE SUPPLEMENTAL PLAN

If you enroll into a Medicare Supplemental plan (also known as Medigap), you will need to bring your Medicare ID card **plus** your Medicare Supplemental ID card to all of your medical appointments. A Medicare Supplemental ID card has a green banner at the top.

(This will be from the insurance company you elect with your licensed Medicare & Individual Health Insurance Consultant.)



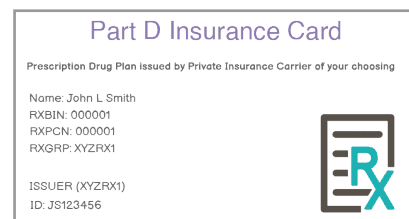
You will need this card to enroll into additional plans.



MEDICARE PART D

If you enroll into a Medicare Prescription drug plan (PDP), you only need to take a Medicare Part D card to the pharmacy to fill your prescriptions.

(This will be from the insurance company you elect with your licensed Medicare & Individual Health Insurance Consultant.)



MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLAN

If you enroll into a Medicare Advantage Plan (also known as Part C), like a HMO, PPO, you will **not** use your Medicare ID card.

Be sure to put this away in a safe spot until you need it again!

Example: You will need this when you visit the doctor/hospital or pharmacy.
